

Open Government:

The Current Town Supervisor also recently said that the Town Board Meeting he convened on 8/26 to re- vote on the PILOT agreement for the Dickerson's Keep Housing Development was a legal meeting. This is incorrect; the Open Meetings Law clearly states that at least 72 hours public notice must be given. Placing a few flyers around the office an hour before the 9am meeting does not constitute adequate public notice – nice try! On September 8th another “special” meeting was also held without appropriate public notice to approve Town bills and abstracts.
